

## Triangle Line Open Season

September 30, 2019

Advanced Energy Experts, Inc. (“AEE”) is pleased to announce that it is conducting a non-binding open season to solicit interest in the transportation on the Triangle Line Pipeline System (“Triangle Line”). Parties interested in subscribing to firm transportation capacity on the Triangle Line as described herein, are requested to submit the Open Season Attachment A by November 15, 2019.

The Triangle Line is anticipated to be a large bi-directional diameter natural gas pipeline that connects the Transcontinental Gas Pipeline, Leidy System (“Transco Leidy Line”) and the Texas Eastern Transmission (“Tetco”) and/or Dominion Transmission (“DTI”) systems in Clinton County, Pennsylvania. “AEE” is soliciting offers from potential customers via a non-binding expression of interest for firm transportation capacity on the Triangle Line. Interested potential customers are invited to contact the AEE representative identified below to submit non-binding bids providing information regarding desired locations, volumes, and timing for potential transportation service in accordance with the terms set forth in this announcement.

### Background Regarding the Triangle Line

The Triangle Line is anticipated to be a high-pressure natural gas pipeline with the ability to transport natural gas from the Transco system to the Tetco/DTI systems at to be determined connection points with new interconnection stations. The Triangle Line is anticipating an online in-service date as early as Q4 2022.

The Triangle Line will be located approximately 10 miles south of the Leidy Storage Facility; thereby providing flexibility and optionality to transport natural gas from the Transco Leidy Line to either Tetco's Leidy Storage Line or DTI's PL1 Line by bypassing the Leidy Storage Facility.

### **Terms of Service and Regulatory Authorization**

This open season and any resulting transportation service agreements shall be expressly subject to applicable regulatory approval. Triangle Line will seek any necessary Public Utilities Commission of Pennsylvania ("PUCP") and Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") approval to provide such service if sufficient binding agreements are ultimately executed as a result of this non-binding open season.

### **Rates for Transportation Service**

The Triangle Line will negotiate with interested potential customers, on a nondiscriminatory basis, with regards to a Demand Fee. AEE anticipates a Demand Fee of approximately \$4.563/Month (\$0.15/Dth). The ultimate Demand Fee will depend on the specific facilities required to support the particular transportation service requested. The Triangle Line also anticipates charging a Commodity and Fuel Retention Fee. The Commodity Fee will be payable on a monthly basis equal to the Commodity Fee multiplied by the monthly aggregate Delivery Volume. In addition, the Triangle Line shall retain gas from each shipper in Dths received each month at the Points of Receipt for transport to the Point(s) of Delivery for Shrinkage.

### **Open Season Process**

The non-binding open season for transportation service begins at 12:00 Noon (ET) on September 30, 2019, and concludes at 5:00 PM (ET) on November 15, 2019. Interested parties should submit a completed non-binding bid form by e-mail to the AEE contact identified below by the conclusion of the open season period.

Interested parties are invited to contact the below the AEE representatives early during the non-binding open season process to discuss the particular transportation service of interest to them. All inquiries or requests for additional information or clarification should be directed to:

After completion of the non-binding open season, AEE will contact all bidders to discuss their specific requests for transportation and the type of service, location, quantities, rates and other contract terms, and the dates by which service is desired. In such discussions, AEE anticipates proceeding with the negotiation of binding transportation service agreements or precedent agreements with interested customers within 60 days of receipt of non-binding bids.

## **Limitations and Reservations**

Subject to regulatory authority, AEE reserves the right to decline to proceed with any transportation services, including with respect to services for which AEE has requested bids in this non-binding open season. In addition, AEE reserves the right to reject any and all bids for transportation services. No request for service will be binding on AEE, or the requesting party, unless and until duly authorized representatives of both parties have executed binding legal agreements.
